

Professor at restorative and endodontics department of Lorraine University Dental Faculty, Nancy. His research interests span the areas of bacterial-dental cells interactions in endodontics, bacterial biofilm formation in the oral cavity, antimicrobial properties of copper and the possible use of copper rich SMA endodontic files during root canal preparation. Nancy in LEM 3 research laboratory for University of Lorraine, CNRS and Arts and Métiers Paris Tech. He is a member of 3 scientific societies and published many referred journal articles in the fields of microbiology, immunity and mechanics. Besides his academic functions, he is a general dentist practitioner since 30 years and with endodontic orientation the last 10 years.

The influence of the lower jaw position on sports performance

Practicing in Ireland, he provides sports dentistry support to multiple athletes, Olympians, professional team sports athletes. John has provided sports dentistry support for major competitions including Baku ISG 2017, Rio Olympics 2016, Baku European Olympics 2015, European boxing championships 2015, Glasgow Commonwealth Games 2014 and London Olympics 2012. He has researched the effect of the lower jaw position on athletic performance while completing his MSc in neuromuscular therapy and contributed a chapter titled "delivering dental facilities in sporting events", to the sports dentistry book "Sports Dentistry: principles and practice". He is a clinical teaching fellow for UCL Eastman Dental Institute and helps deliver the world's only masters in sports dentistry program.



Johanna Herzog, DDS (GER) The centric bite registration

Since 2017 she is a dentist at the dental practice Edel & Weiss in Nuremberg, specializing in sports Dentistry and the care of multiple Olympic champions and professional athletes, as well as the triathlon federal base Nuremberg. Additional research and scientific work in cooperation with Priv.-Doz. Dr. Daniela Ohlendorf (University of Frankfurt am Main). The subject of this research is the possibility of optimizing the athletes in dentistry.
